Building play and social skills, an interactive group program

Designed for children 5-8 years with social learning difficulties or mild to moderate Autism Spectrum Disorder. This program is led by allied health therapists and focuses on developing essential communication and social skills.

Each child has a specific role, and they work together as a team to build a model while practising other vital skills such as sharing, turn-taking, listening, joint attention and problem-solving. They'll have fun, explore their creativity and interact with others in a supported environment.



What we'll work on

- **Collaboration** – by working as a group to achieve a common goal
- **Joint problem solving, sharing and turn-taking** – taking turns in different roles, working on the build together
- **Maintaining attention** – staying focused on the task to build the models
- **Verbal and non-verbal communication** – using language and non-verbal skills to express ideas and feelings
- **Conflict resolution** – working through differences for a shared aim
- **Creativity** – in coming up with a group name, building the models and free playtime
- **Fine motor skills** – for manipulating the Lego® blocks
